

American Welding Society and Rhoads Industries High School Welding Competition: Challenging the Next Generation of Skilled Workers

Philadelphia, PA, March 19, 2018 – The American Welding Society (AWS) and Rhoads Industries (Rhoads) will host students from high schools across the five-county Philadelphia region to compete in a shielded metal arch weld (SMAW) competition on Saturday, March 23, 2019 in Philadelphia, PA.

The participating schools will elect a top-standing student to represent their high school at this regional competition. The chosen students will participate in a competition designed to test their ability and proficiency to employ specific welding processes. This competition will award gold, silver and bronze prizes to the top three participants, and the grand prize winner will receive a \$2,500 scholarship. All competitors will walk away with welding gear and valuable experience.
