CLIENT SITUATION

In July of 2015, Rhoads was awarded a contract for the removal of main engines, CPP systems, shafting, propellers, rudders, main and auxiliary generator set and various engineering and electronic equipment from five de-commissioned Oliver Hazard Perry-Class Guided Missile Frigates.

The project involved successive dry dockings of the five ships as well as extensive pier-side work to remove various engineering components.
